

Directions to the house from Alicante Airport

The area/valley that the house is in, is called 'Portichol' and the nearest town is Javea.

(YOU WILL NEED TO HAVE ABOUT 7 EUROS FOR THE TOLL ON THE MOTORWAY)

When you come out of the airport car park TURN RIGHT get into the middle lane and carry straight on UNTIL YOU MEET THE JUNCTION (at the end of the carparks) Then turn left and following the signs to **VALENCIA** (E15 & A7)

After a hundred metres or so there is a bend to the left - move into the right hand lane and feed onto the main road round to the right.

Once on the main road take the **third** turning to **Valencia (A7 and E15)** (blue sign) and stay on this road – which will take you past Alicante and lead you onto the toll motorway. You take a ticket from the yellow machine and pay when you leave the motorway.

You want to exit the motorway at **JUNCTION 62** sign-posted to – **ONDARA - DENIA - JAVEA**.

Take the immediate right, after paying, signed to **JAVEA**. You will see a sign – 'JAVEA 13 Kilometres' -.

Join the main road and after a big DIY warehouse called **BRICOMAN** indicate right and turn off.

Carry on straight over the roundabouts and after 4 kilometres you will pass 2 petrol stations either side of the road. This is just to reassure you that you are still on the right road.

Keep going straight and 3 kilometers later having just gone around a bend to the right you come to a large new roundabout with iron seagulls in the middle in the shape of a boat sail.

There is a large warehouse called Bricotop. Take the right turning – signed to **Benitachell**.

1.5 kilometres later you come to another large roundabout – go all the way around and take the last turn off – if you are approaching at 6oclock you are turning off at 9oclock.

Go along this road. After a while you will come to another roundabout – carry straight over, past the little garden triangle on the left and carrying a staggered straight on going past the road to the left, just be careful with the traffic coming down this hill – it looks like you can't go straight over but trust me, you can – the signs are just a bit confusing. You then pass a car park on the left with a flag for a restaurant called Carrasco on the right, and just further on there's a funny Y Junction. You carry straight on (well, it sort of feels like it's round to the right). - but stop first to give way to traffic at this junction. **It has very poor 'give way' sign.**

So, carry straight on (you are nearly there).

You will pass a shop on the left called Saladar– carry straight on – the road goes around a sharp bend to the right past the Farmacia on the right. Then you will pass a complex and the local shop on the left called '**Toscamar**'- carry straight on - you are still on the right road. You are only about 45 seconds away.

A few seconds later on your right hand side you will pass a restaurant called '**L'Escut**'. Carry straight on following the bend round to the left. It might look like the road goes straight on up the hill – follow the road round to the left and not to the right.

By now you are within shouting distance.

Take this last bit really slowly. There are a couple of tight bends.

Take the next little lane to the right called Carrer Del Celiandre. Travel up the lane and take the next left through the pillars, if the gates are open! up a gravel drive. If the gate is closed just give a little discreet beep of the horn!! The entrance door is facing you up the steps. ENJOY!
